## **Regulations Concerning Courses Offered and the Number of Credits Assigned to Each Course at the School of International and Area Studies of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies**

The Regulations Concerning Courses Offered and the Number of Credits Assigned to Each Course at the School of International and Area Studies of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (established on March 27, 2012) shall be amended in its entirety as follows.

### Article 1 Purpose

These Regulations provide for necessary matters relating to the courses offered by the School of International and Area Studies and the number of credits assigned to each course in accordance with Article 29 of the University Regulations of National University Corporation Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (established on April 1, 1977).

### Article 2 Global Liberal Arts Program

1 The School of International and Area Studies shall offer the Global Liberal Arts Program as the general program for the School of International and Area Studies, the School of Language and Culture Studies, and the School of Japan Studies (hereinafter referred to “All the Schools”). Such program shall consist of the groups and categories of courses shown in the table below.

2 In addition to those provided in the preceding paragraph, Teaching Courses available in All the Schools shall be offered for satisfying requirements to obtain teacher certification.

Article 3 Foundation Courses

The Foundation Courses shall be given as lectures, and the courses shown in Appended Table 1 shall be offered.

Article 4 Liberal Arts Courses

The Liberal Arts Courses shall be given as lectures, seminars, or practical courses, and the courses shown in Appended Table 2 shall be offered.

Article 5 Language Courses

The Language Courses shall be given as seminars, and the courses shown in Appended Table 3 shall be offered.

Article 6 Area Related Courses

The Area Related Courses shall be given as lectures, and the courses shown in Appended Table 4 shall be offered.

Article 7 Core Seminar Program

The School of International and Area Studies shall offer the Core Seminar Program, which program shall consist of the groups and categories of courses shown in the table below.

Article 8 Introductory Courses

The Introductory Courses shall be given as lectures, and the courses shown in Appended Table 5 shall be offered.

Article 9 Survey Courses

The Survey Courses shall be given as lectures, and the courses shown in Appended Table 6 shall be offered.

Article 10 Major Courses

The Major Courses shall be given as lectures, and the courses shown in Appended Table 7 shall be offered.

Article 11 Graduation Project

1 The Graduation Project shall be completed by writing a thesis, etc.

2 Eight (8) credits shall be assigned to the Graduation Project.

#### Article 12 Related Courses

The Core Seminar Program of other schools and the credits acquired in other universities shall be regarded as Related Courses.

#### Article 13 Teaching Courses

- 1 As for Teaching Courses, “courses relating to school subjects and teaching methods,” “courses relating to basic understanding of education,” “courses relating to teaching methods for moral education and integrated studies, student counseling and guidance, educational consultation, and other matters,” “courses relating to educational practice,” and “courses required by the university” are offered for students who plan to satisfy requirements to obtain teacher certification. The courses described in the previous paragraph are offered as lectures, seminars, or practical courses.
- 2 The courses referred to in the preceding paragraph shall be given as lectures, seminars, or practical courses, and the courses offered and the number of credits assigned to each course shall be as shown in Appendices 8 to 11.
- 3 The handling of credits assigned to teaching practice and teaching practicum seminar shall be prescribed separately.

##### Supplementary provisions

- 1 These Regulations shall be effective as of April 1, 2019.
- 2 Notwithstanding the provisions of the Regulations as amended, the courses offered and the number of credits assigned to each course for the students who are already enrolled as of March 31, 2019 shall continue to be governed by the provisions of these Regulations then in force.
- 1 Among the Teaching Courses for the students who are already enrolled as of March 31, 2019, notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, “Social Studies Teaching Methods I: 4 credits” and “Social Studies Teaching Methods II: 4 credits” as provided for in Appended Table 8 before amendment shall be superseded by with the courses offered and number of credits assigned to each course shown under “Social Studies & Geography and History Teaching Methods 1: 2 credits,” “Social Studies & Geography and History Teaching Methods 2: 2 credits,” “Social Studies Teaching Methods 3: 2 credits,” and “Social Studies Teaching Methods 4: 2 credits” as provided for in Appendices 8 and 9 as amended.

##### Supplementary provisions

- 1 These Regulations shall be effective as of April 1, 2024.
- 2 For the Area Related Courses for the students who are already enrolled as of March 31, 2019, “Area Basics 2B (East Asia 4): 2 credits” shall be added to Appended Table 4 before amendment.
- 3 For the Liberal Arts Courses for the students who are already enrolled as of March 31, 2019, “Artificial Intelligence and Data Science A: 2 credits” and “Artificial Intelligence and Data Science B: 2 credits” shall be added to Appended Table 5 before amendment.
- 4 Among the Teaching Courses for the students who are already enrolled as of March 31, 2019, the courses offered and number of credits assigned to each course shown in the left hand column in the table below as provided for in Appendices 6 and 7 before amendment shall be superseded by the courses offered and number of credits assigned to each course shown in the right hand column of the same table.

Remarks 1: Students who plan to obtain Type I senior high school teaching certification need to earn twelve (12) credits; those who plan to obtain Type I junior high school teaching certification need to earn four (4) credits.

Remarks 2: Students may use the following credits as credits under the category of “courses required by the university,” provided in Article 5-1 of the Education Personnel Certification Act:

- (i) Credits earned beyond the minimum number of credits required under the category of “specialized educational contents relating to the school subject concerned”
- (ii) Credits earned beyond the minimum number of credits required under the category of “teaching methods for each subject (including the use of information equipment and teaching materials)” (this applies only to students who plan to obtain Type I senior high school teaching certification)
- (iii) Credits earned beyond the minimum number of credits required by TUFs under the category of “courses relating to basic understanding of education” or the category of “courses relating to teaching methods for moral education and integrated studies, student counseling and guidance, educational consultation, and other matters”
- (iv) Credits earned by students who plan to obtain Type I senior high school teaching certification from Moral Education Guidance Studies under the category of “courses required by the university”
